Minutes of the IQAC meeting Thursday 11.12.2014

At the beginning, Dr. A. J. Khandagale, Coordinator, IQAC welcomed Dr. Nitin Ghorpade, the Chairperson and all other members of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).

Dr. Nitin Ghorpade, Chairperson (IQAC) in his introductory remarks appreciated the efforts taken by the members of IQAC and the decisions taken in the last meeting held on 20/6/2014 of IQAC and the activities during the last semester. The steps taken by the institute towards quality assurance are mentioned below. IQAC promotes faculties to use more student centric teaching methods and organize guest lectures for faculty on effective use of ICT. It also encourages students for the organization of research project presentations and promote the selected ones for the AVISHKAR competition and encourages faculties to undertake research projects and publications.

Information of CAS was shared with the faculty members and especially those who had to apply for promotion through CAS. To apply for the DBT Star College scheme, IQAC prepared the proposal for the same by the committee formed for the said purpose.

The IQAC Coordinator has given whole responsibility to the Departments and decided the coordinator for the Seminar/ Workshop and Conferences for execution of the activities.

The different aspects of initiatives for enhancing the quality and their guidance programme will be organized for teaching faculty. All members unanimously decided that the Professional Development programme on "Quality Enhancement" will be organized by the IQAC.

Agenda No. 4: Utilization of UGC grants and Purchase of equipment.

UGC approved Rs. 16 lakh grant under the scheme of Under-Graduate Development Assistance during XII Plan period. Out of this, the college received Rs. 6,40,000/- which is to be utilized during 2014-15. The college also received Rs. 3 lakh from UGC for establishment and monitoring of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell. IQAC reviewed the list of items purchased under these schemes. The lists of items to be purchased under these schemes were provided by the respective departments to college UGC committee. Dr. N. R. Dangat shared the list of items in the meeting with justification.

The utilization of the purchase for financial assistance to colleges under the scheme of providing additional assistance to colleges was submitted to IQAC for approval.

Decision: The lists submitted for purchase of items by the college UGC committee was approved and suggested that proper procedure set by PDEA should be used for purchases. The utilization of the purchase for financial assistance to colleges under the scheme of providing additional assistance to colleges was submitted to IQAC was approved and directed to submit it to UGC.

Agenda No. 5: To plan for the implementation of the DST-FIST scheme

Department of Science and Technology, Government of India sanctioned Rs. 80,00000/-under DST-FIST Scheme for research and teaching-learning purposes by vide Letter No. SR/FST/College-224/2014 dated 21 November 2014. Dr. Nitin Ghorpade discussed proponents of the scheme that are sanctioned under the scheme. He also discussed the list

shipment to be purchased under this scheme.

Decision: The committee unanimously decided to plan for the best implementation of the scheme. This scheme provides funds for equipment required for teaching and for research purpose along with funds for books, networking and maintenance. The DST-FIST implementation should be done through the meeting of the HOD of the science subjects along with the vice principals and Principal. The requirement should be prepared and submitted to the head office. The PDEA head office shall look into the purchase matter on a centralized basis.

Most of the teachers are involved in research activities. Dr. N. R. Dangat discussed the need to increase research facility for teachers and students. Since college received Grants under DST-FIST, it will be beneficial for students and teachers. IQAC proposed that the college should develop separate Instrumentation laboratory for equipment to be purchased under DST-FIST.

Decision: IQAC decided to provide financial assistance for teachers to present papers in International, National and State level conferences/ seminars organized within India. IQAC suggested that the college should organize workshop on research methodology. IQAC also suggested that college research committee should motivate teachers to undertake interdisciplinary research activity. IQAC also approved the proposal for separate Instrumentation laboratory.

Agenda 7: Strengthening the placement cell.

College has established Placement cell in the college. Activities conducted by the Placement cell were discussed in the meeting. Members gave suggestions for strengthening of placement cell.

The resume of the registered students should be publicised by the cell so get proper opportunities to all the students. Sessions on personality and communication skills should be conducted through the cell. The placement and various competitive examination notices should be brought into notice of the students. Agenda 2: To take review of quality enhancement activities.

Decision: It was decided that each department must take a review of various teaching methods that can be used for their subject. Use of ICT must be promoted. Workshops on teaching methods and preparing effective presentations must be organized for teachers. IQAC anonymously decided to arrange Awareness lectures for students about participation in different activities..

Action Taken

Use of teaching kits for better understanding of students was practiced. Survey methods for some subjects were used. All the HODs were asked to monitor the teaching – learning process in their department. A review of the teachings methods was taken at the end of the year. AVISHKAR Orientation Workshop was arranged for students 4/9/2014. Mathematical Ability Awareness Programme (MAAP) program for students is scheduled on 18/1/2014. Science Exhibition is scheduled on 12/1/22014. Study tours are arranged by Geography, Botany and Zoology departments.

Agenda 3: To strengthen the research activity on the campus.

Decision: The research committee proposed to make a compendium of the research articles published by the faculty members. Members of IOAC anonymously decided to take requirement of equipment for research from departments and the college will purchase such equipment. The faculty advised to participate international and national conferences/seminars etc. Research competitions to create interest in research activities should be conducted for the students. Conducting events like AVISHKAR, University initiative of research competition for students. Encouraging student research projects for making students aware of research.

The research committee has taken steps towards encouraging research in the college. Compilation of research articles published by the faculty in the form of a compendium was prepared by the committee. Students were encouraged to participate in the AVISHKAR competition.20 students qualified for the university level while 02 qualified for the state level AVISHKAR.

Faculty members participated in International/National level seminars and conferences. The research centre have planned their academic work as per the university guidelines and conducted course work of the admitted students. The college started process for purchasing of Equipments required for research purpose. These equipment are to be purchased under DST-FIST grant.

Agenda 4: To apply for research grants.

Decision: It was decided that the college should promote research by encouraging the faculty to apply for grants for research from agencies like UGC, SPPU etc.

The department wise meetings were conducted to promote the teachers to apply for the research projects. The UGC and Research committee guided the teachers to apply for the grants and provided necessary support and documents for the same.

One minor project has been submitted while 4 minor and 1 major are ongoing. The research committee guides the PI for proper progress of the project.

Agenda 5: Career advancement scheme:

Decision: The CAS process was discussed and its importance was ORE ART.

The IQAC explained the CAS scheme and its need for the faculty. The API scores of the faculty were initially assessed by the HOD and then by the IQAC to finalize the Scores. The documents were verified. The faculty who had to apply for promotion through CAS were told to make four files of the documents required for the process.

Agenda 6: To apply for the DBT STAR college scheme.

Decision: The importance of this scheme was explained by the IAQC coordinator, and it was decided to apply for the scheme in time.

The proposal for the DBT STAR college scheme was prepared and discussed amongst the faculty members of Science departments. This was done by the committee formed for it. The same was submitted to the DBT office.

Agenda 7: To plan for the implementation of the DST FIST scheme

Decision: Proper implementation of this scheme will improve the quality of education. The laboratory facilities will improve which will support teaching and research activities. The lists of all requirement have been prepared by the head of all science departments. The same was discussed in the research committee along with the IQAC members. A few suggestions in the make of some equipment and configuration of the proposed computer purchase were given. A provision for prepayment or advance payment to the dealers was also approved.
